## PROGRAM INFORMATION

### SESSION DESCRIPTION

This program is designed to provide education, information and updates for facility staff, including administrators and owners, about the New York State Medicaid Case Mix Program and OMIG audits.

With the inception of the Office of the Medicaid Inspector General (OMIG) audits, facilities are faced with conflicts, confusion and citations about requirements for MDS item capture, and documentation of items that drive reimbursement. The lack of regulations formally issued by the state and the never-ending conflicting reports of interpretation by policy makers and industry stakeholders alike add to the significant financial penalties absent of NYSDOH guidance for "Standards of Documentation".

This program is designed to present recent findings and penalties by the NYS OMIG to help facilities better understand MDS standards of practice and rules for assessment, documentation and capture of payment drivers. Working with multiple State associations and hundreds of facilities throughout the country, Zimmet Healthcare Services Group, LLC provides training and guidance to providers on accurate care and capture of assessments utilizing appropriate standards of practices, rules and regulations to meet reimbursement requirements.
